



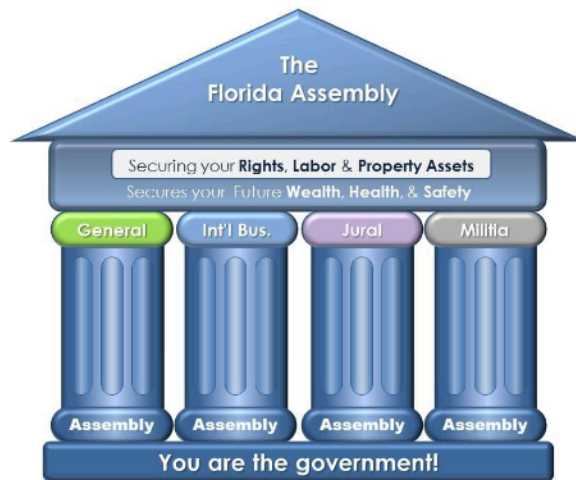
The Florida Assembly

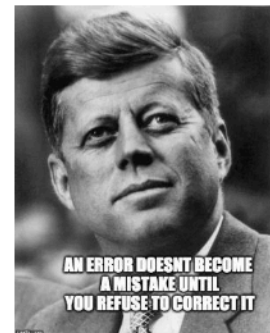

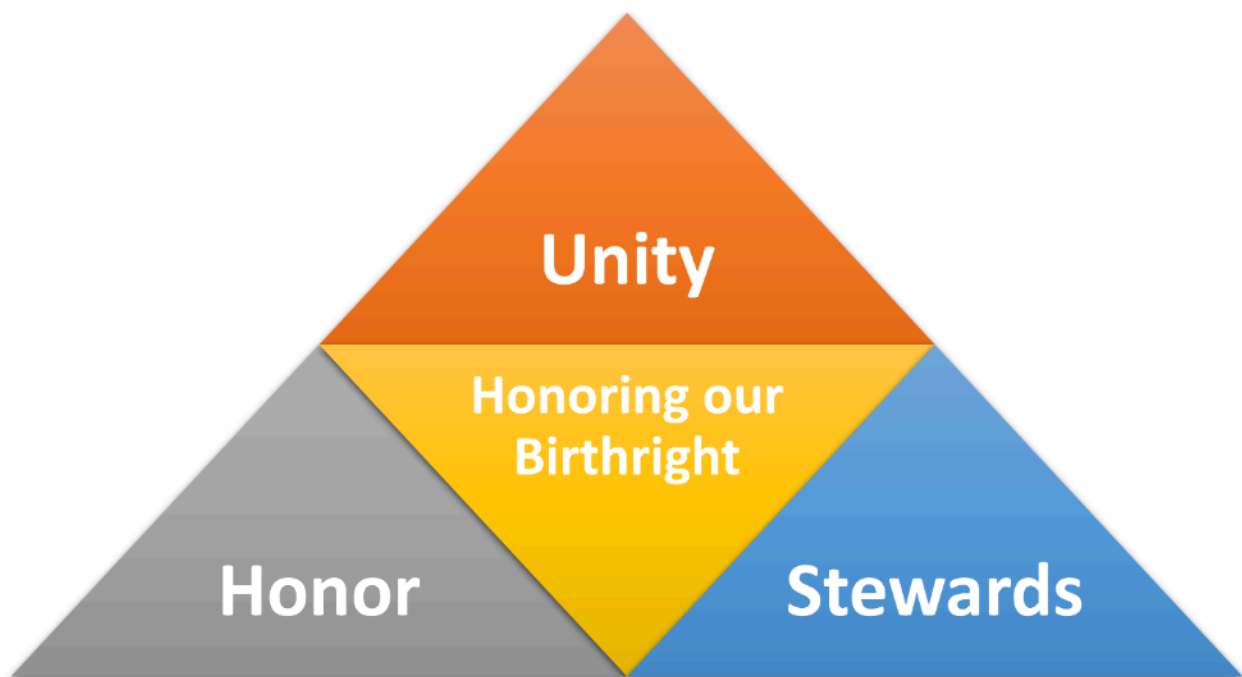

The Florida Assembly is honorable, peaceable, productive, and lawful— an assembly that is safely guided, committed to restoring the lawful government, enforcing the Public Law, and upholding the Constitutional Guarantees owed to Florida and Floridians.

Assembly Members

To be a member of The Florida Assembly in good standing peoples must have corrected their political status using the #928 Basic Package of editable forms, and/or The 1779 One Pager, with 2 witness testimonies and photocopy of the birth certificate and have recorded this paperwork with a Florida Recording Secretary International Notarial Witness then have the paperwork published into our official Land Recording systems or a State of State recording office. Once the political status correction is completed the people may choose to participate in The Florida Assembly.

Currently The American States Assembly Land Recording Office (LRO) is the recognized publishing system for The Florida Assembly. Using the LRO consolidates assembly members and the credential card links to your paperwork and E-Verify works for checking peoples paperwork for qualified electors, officials, and other verification processes. **E-Verify** – Enter a Record Number or other search data to find/verify an American State National. Those who are ineligible electors as Florida State Citizen or as a Florida American State National status are those with apparent health disabilities that are not capable of handling such a position, in other words, not able to make cognitive decisions because of the disability. Anyone in the Assembly can bring the situation to anyone in The Oversight Committee for a review to decide if it is apparent.

Some items include:

-  One Page Declaration — The 1779 Naturalization Act (now required for all elected officials)
-  Deed of Reconveyance, or Deed of Conveyance
 - ✓ (The latter document(Deed of Conveyance) is only for first generation naturalized immigrants.)
-  *Optional, include the New Diagram of Fraud 2019 (pdf) with this Document
-  Certificate of Assumed Names
-  Act of Expatriation
 - ✓ Act of Expatriation (Example — JOHN DOE)
 - ✓ Act of Expatriation (Example — JOHN M. DOE)
 - ✓ Act of Expatriation (Example - JOHN MARK DOE)
-  Note: If you have any other birth names on your Birth Certificate, more Act of Expatriation papers need to be created. If you do not have a middle name, then you will only have one page.
-  Cancellation of All Prior Powers of Attorney
-  FSIA (Foreign Sovereign Immunities Act)
-  Paramount Claim of the Life (Example — The Estate of Evelyn Jane Carter)
-  Record of Life (Previously named Baby Claim Deed of Land Recording)
-  Lineage Treaty
-  Record of Lawful Marriage (Previously named Marriage Paperwork)

Participation

When participating in The Florida Assembly, verification of the land recorded paperwork listed above is required or the one pager with the 2 witness

testimonies properly recorded and published. Being a member of The Florida Assembly is a right and a privilege so the people as an assembly have rights also.

If you are coming from another state, you will be required to provide your land recorded number, date, County, and State if it is available online for verification, and/or copies of your paperwork. The year and a day on Florida are for eligibility as a juror, elector, official. If you're not currently standing on the land, you cannot be a participant/member. (Land jurisdiction does not allow for dual jurisdiction.)

Guests

Guests are those who have not Land Recorded their paperwork, and those who have been invited to a meeting as guests. Guests are not allowed to participate, unless asked by the assembly, during the business meeting. However, after the business meeting, they may participate in the discussion session. A letter of intent can be completed while in the process of completing the paperwork

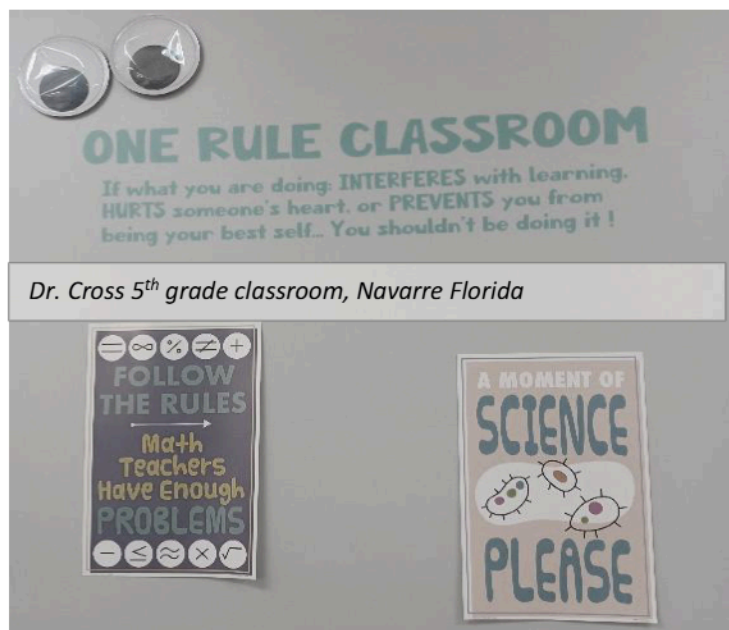


Figure 1 If what you are doing INTERFERES with learning, HURTS someone's heart, or PREVENTS you from being your best self. You shouldn't be doing it !

Moves on the Floor

All peoples have equal rights and the same obligations. When the floor is open for moves and discussion, the moves being brought to the floor come from the committee's team lead facilitator or designated speaker. There may be a time when time is of the essence and a move brought forward.

When the floor is closed for a specific business function, so are moves until the business is completed and the floor is open. The Florida Assembly is structured and driven by committees. The move can be deliberated in committee and due diligence applied for a clear wording of the move and impact on our mission. Full and free discussion of every move is open to all Florida State Nationals and Florida State Citizens. After the discussion the move is read, amended if desired by mover, seconded, and election held to pass or return to the committee for further research. Election by yays, nays or abstain.

Asking for the Floor

Wait until recognized by the Chair/moderator of the meeting.

Only one question or move at a time may be considered, and only one people may have the floor at any one time. When requesting to speak, state "may I and your name", raise your hand is the preferred method on webinars, then voice your name and county when called upon by the moderator. Once you are recognized, the floor is yours for three minutes, after which the one with the floor states "I yield." Participants have a right to know what the immediate pending question or move is and after discussion to have it restated before the question or move goes forward.

We may use our own version or methods that work well for us from the latest edition of RONR when discovering various elements of administrating a successful meeting. [Robert's Rules of Order Newly Revised](#) – also known as RONR which was published in September 2020.

Behaviors

Personal negative remarks and/or disruptive behavior are always out of order, regardless of whether it takes place during a meeting, through emails, or phone calls. Perpetrators may be prohibited during any meetings, conference calls and/or participation in assembly business.

Disruptive behavior examples are related to the following:

- 🏠 Malicious gossip
- 🏠 People raising "concerns" of a juvenile or petty nature
- 🏠 Using such "concerns" to spread doubt and mistrust of any participant, or functions within the group or assembly
- 🏠 Deliberate miscommunication between working groups and participants
- 🏠 Unnecessary talk about fear and danger, fearmongering
- 🏠 Petty or unsubstantiated accusations of wrong-doing
- 🏠 Passive aggressive behavior
- 🏠 Sending unwarranted and personal attacks through e-mails or any other media
- 🏠 Promoting personal financial gain using the assembly as a platform to generate clients or consumers for their enterprise. We do have opportunities for private assembly trades to share their trade and how it supports our mission
- 🏠 Attack the Leaders: Coordinator, Anna, James
- 🏠 Attack the foundational elements
- 🏠 Attack any progress made so far
- 🏠 Divide and Conquer
- 🏠 Accuse others of what they are doing themselves
- 🏠 Attempt to set up a gravy train out of Assembly Members
- 🏠 Secret Meetings/Agendas
- 🏠 Attack Assembly ability to make money
- 🏠 Hijack Agenda
- 🏠 Lead with Ego: Me, me, me, I, I, I
- 🏠 Elect themselves into several different offices especially where they can control the assets, or what they think of as "power" offices which we don't have.
- 🏠 Try to create conflict and fight, fight, fight.

Settling Disputes and Reporting Concerns

Please note all members would benefit from working with their County Organizer/Chairman or Ombudsman when seeking to settle any disputes, infractions, concerns, and questions before going to the state coordinator, assembly chair, or Anna. The Federation is not a part of The Florida Assembly and cannot make any decisions regarding The Florida Assembly basic operations unless course correction is required. We are grateful that the Federation and Anna provide guidance to all states. Their support helps us stay on course, remain within our jurisdictions, and complete the reconstruction.

The misbehaviors will be reviewed and discerned by the Course of Conduct/Good Standing Oversight Committee appointed by The Florida Assembly Ombuds.

The moderator or Marshal at Arms for The Florida Assembly has the authority to mute any disruptor and/or remove them from the call.

Course of Conduct/Good Standing Oversight Committee

The Course of Conduct/Good Standing Oversight Committee is formed by the Ombuds. They review any infractions of the above and any clear and present dangers to the people. They create and recommend a course of action and procedures for actions to be taken, if any. We are all responsible people who are safely guided and self-govern as prudent peoples. Some concerns may be of a private nature and should remain private. Some incidents are clear and present dangers and escalate to the level required to diffuse the situation.

Oversight Committees need to be under the control of Ombudsmen Committees that protect the rights of individual Assembly members, other Assembly Committees, and officials of the Assembly---- and they need to be subject to review by the General Assembly. Otherwise, they can be abused and abusive.

The true function of an Oversight Committee is to be on hand when and if there are serious allegations of criminal behavior, such as theft, insurrection, purposeful obstruction, selling information about the Assembly or its members, etc. that are backed up with credible evidence. Their role is to investigate and make recommendations about such allegations --- which they then bring to the Sheriff's

Office, the Continental or U.S. Marshals, or the General Assembly itself --- for further investigation and/or prosecution.

The committee will report on their findings at the next Assembly meeting after the incident has been reviewed. A participant can appeal in writing (e.g., email). The Course of Conduct/Good Standing Oversight Committee will review the appeal, deliberate, and present a final determination. It takes 2/3rds of the Course of Conduct/Good Standing Oversight Committee to affirm any determination and if brought before the assembly a 2/3rds decision by roll call. All interrupters and Provocateurs will be added to an incident report with a simple description. A County Chairman/Organizer being reviewed by the Course of Conduct/Good Standing Committee cannot participate in their determination.

A two-thirds decision of the Course of Conduct/Good Standing Committee is required for any determination to pass. The election results must be sent to the State Coordinator or Chair prior to the meeting following the decision. A return confirmation by the State Coordinator or Chair is sent to the Ombuds.

Correction Actions

Course of behavior adjustment or penalties, determined by the Course of Conduct/Good Standing Oversight Committee, are relevant to the circumstances. A couple of examples are listed below for details:

Interrupters:

Removed from business meetings and any committee meetings for a minimum of 30 days. Upon returning they serve a probationary period of (3) three months.

Agent provocateur:

Removed from business meetings and any committee meetings for a determined minimum time frame of (1) one year or less, or a permanent ban. Upon returning, if not banned, they serve a probationary period of (3) three months with no electing and no committee meetings.

Those that have chosen to leave The Florida Assembly, through verbal or written notice, and then return, must go through the 928 committee to be re-vetted to join the assembly again. Once through the 928 committee they also have a (3)

three-month probationary period before they can gain elector rights as well as being able to work on any committee for those (3) three months.

Those that have chosen to take a sabbatical, for more than (6) months, for reasons other than health, or bereavement need to include in writing a brief explanation for the sabbatical and send that to both their County Chairman/Organizer and State Coordinator/Chair. They will need to resubmit their paperwork to the 928 committee for re-vetting upon returning.

The Oversight Committee has authority to course correct all committees and is made up of participants in good standing who have continually contributed to The Florida Assembly for a minimum of (2) two years. Participation is limited to those with the experience of active participation in committee work and holding official positions, and other assembly work/functions.

Decisions made by the Oversight Committee are final. All participants come to join the Oversight Committee by invitation only by the Ombuds. Review: 3320.

Requirements for any elected position(s)



Before being nominated for any elected position, candidates are referred to the Nomination Committee and complete validation procedures to ensure all paperwork is in order. Nominees will provide a written bio showing that they have some knowledge and/or experience for that position and their desire to qualify for that position to the Nomination Committee.

Candidates complete a verbal quiz confirming knowledge of our assembly and state. The quiz will be administered by one of the members of the vetting committee. If the quiz is accepted, then they can move forward and accept the nomination at the next state business assembly meeting.

Process flow:

-  Candidate nomination request
-  Candidate validation process
-  Vetting Committee review and follow-up
-  Nomination Committee brings move to floor
-  If passed, candidate verification and validation process

-  Affirmation process
-  Official position occupied and operating

Note: All elected positions come with a (90) ninety-day probationary period. Those unable to satisfactorily perform the duties required by the position will be notified and asked to step down by The Course of Conduct/Good Standing Oversight Committee . All work and materials given to you by the county or state, and/or the federation must be returned within (24) twenty-four hours of notice. If you do not comply you will be removed from the position publicly and lose your ability to hold any position for a period of (1) one year.
